1. WHAT IS THE EBW II?

The “Euro Brazilian Windows II” project (EBW II) is a consortium of European and Brazilian institutions in the area of higher education. This project is financed by the European Commission through the “Erasmus Mundus Programme (Action 2)”, which is one of EU’s cooperation programme with third countries.

The main objectives of this initiative are:

- To promote mobility of students, academic staff and researchers from Europe to Brazil, enabling valuable experiences at linguistic, cultural and educational level;
- To enhance the international cooperation capacity between Brazilian and European Higher Education Institutions (HEI);
- To promote the transparency and recognition of studies and qualifications at international level;

The EBW is aimed at European undergraduate and doctorate students, post-doctorate researchers and academic staff willing to undertake a mobility period in Brazilian partner institutions.

In addition to the scholarship, the EBW II project also covers: travel costs to the selected country; health insurance (travel, health, accident); and the registration fees for mobility periods of, and over, 10 months at the host institution. The project also foresees a fee waiver policy for exchanges of less than 10 months.

3. WHO CAN APPLY

To be eligible for a mobility, applicants should meet the following requirements:

- To be national of one European country;
- Good proficiency of the language of the host institution (Portuguese);
- In case of post-doctorate mobility, have been awarded the doctorate in the last two years and have the support of one European partner institution in the consortium;
- Undergraduate students must have successfully concluded at least one year of studies in their home institution;
- To be registered or enrolled in one of the following European Higher Education Institutions:

University of Ghent, Belgium; Grenoble Institute of Technology, France; Technical University of Dresden, Germany; Budapest University of Technology and Economics, Hungary; Technical University of Valencia, Spain; Technical University of Catalunya, Spain; University of Deusto, Spain; University of Lund, Sweden; Technical University of Eindhoven, The Netherlands; University of Porto, Portugal
